



WELCOME TO THE M LAZY C RANCH!

ATV/SXS/Any OHV Riders:

It seems like a lot of rules, but they are only in place for the safety and enjoyment of our guests!

Because guest safety is our new number 1 priority, and because we are a working ranch with horses, livestock, wildlife etc. we have put in place rules regarding the use of any motorized vehicle while on property.

It is as simple as

- **Respecting the ranch, the other guests, children, and animals by**
 - **Not speeding (stay under 10mph)**
 - **Not revving your engine**
 - **Not stirring up dust**
 - **Keeping an eye out for guests, children, animals of any kind by being considerate and following the yield graphic below**
 - **No driving after 10pm and not before 8am (exception: hunters)**

ALL guests must keep their ATV/SXS/OHV/MOTORCYCLES's in primitive camping by the ATV/SXS/OHV access trail. PARK ALONG THE FENCE. You MUST use the assigned ATV/SXS/OHV/MOTORCYCLE Trail around the perimeter of the property to access the main road. If these rules are not abided by, we will require that your ATV/SXS/OHV remain on your trailer and not driven on property for the remainder of the stay. You will then have to trailer your ATV/SXS/OHV to the trailhead at the FS 247-interchange moving forward.

In additional to our ranch rules, Colorado has stringent laws in place regarding off-road vehicles. It is Colorado law to abide by the following:

- **Pull to the side of the trail far enough for horses to pass safely as soon as you see them or within 50 yards whichever is farthest.**
- **Pull to the downhill side of the trail if possible since horses tend to perceive unknown threats on the uphill side as predators.**
- **Shut off your motor as soon as possible and remove your helmet. The horse will be more likely to recognize you as a human.**



- **Speak to the rider and horse in a friendly, relaxed tone.**

- **When approaching horses from behind, stop, call ahead and make yourself known to the rider. Ask them if it is OK to pass and the best way to do so.**



- **No unaccompanied minors are allowed to drive on the forest land. It is a federal law when driving on federal land that only licensed drivers can drive any motorized vehicles. All minors HAVE to wear a helmet according to Colorado Law.**

- **While on the ranch should you or anyone in your party exceed the 10mph speed limit and/or drive your vehicle in an unsafe manner your card on file will be charged \$500. No warnings. Upon the 2nd time, you will be escorted off the premises. This is again to ensure the safety of everyone at the ranch, especially those on horseback.**

***Remember your minor children are under your control and you will be held responsible for their actions as well.**

I hereby agree to these rules and will abide by them during my entire stay at M Lazy C Ranch. If I or anyone in my party break these rules listed above, I authorize M Lazy C Ranch to charge my card \$500.
